


ACCESSING EBSCOHOST TEMPORARY WORKAROUND

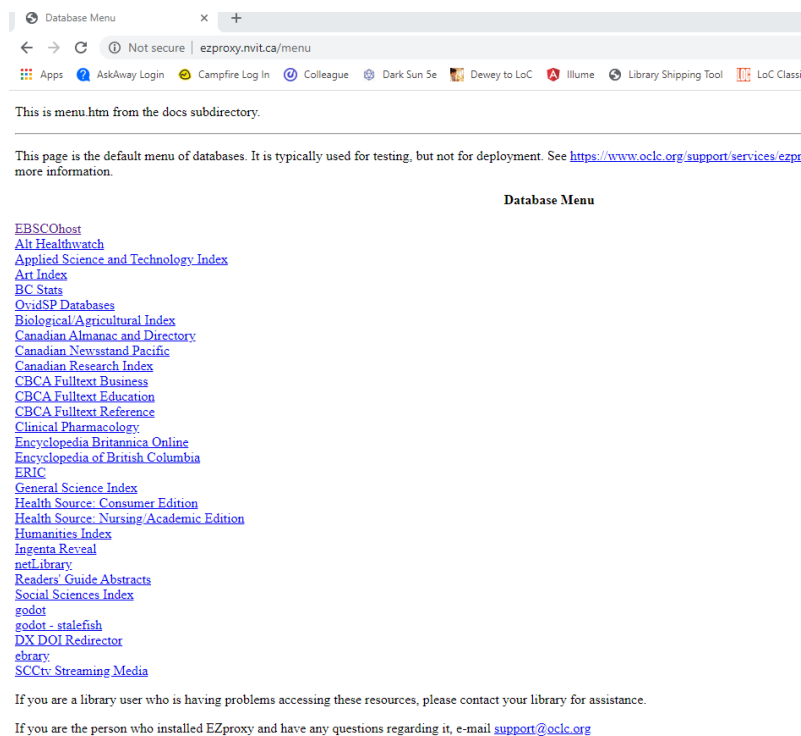
Step 1: In your preferred browser (Chrome works best, but Safari, Firefox, or Edge should work too), type ezproxy.nvit.ca in the navigation bar.

Step 2: You should see a screen like the one shown below. Enter your NVIT user credentials to proceed.



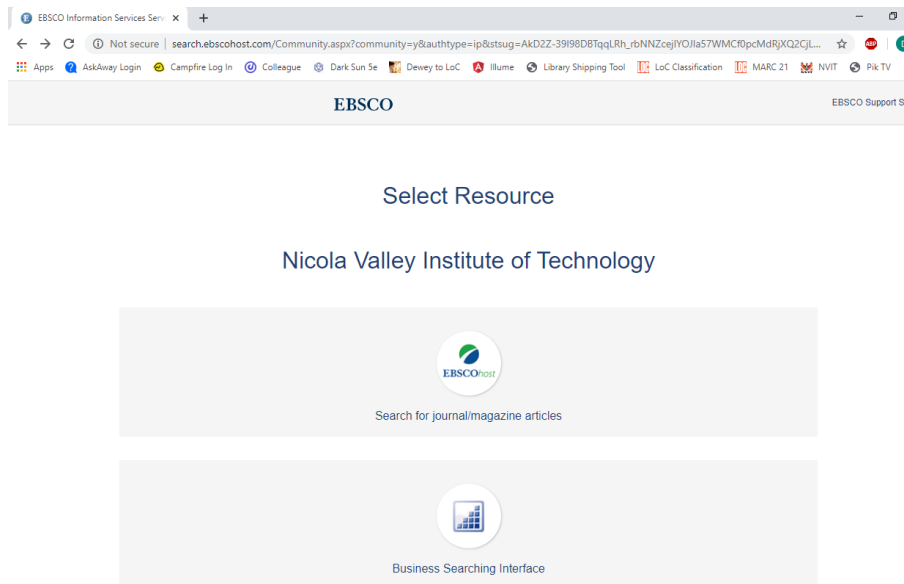

Step 3: The next screen should look like the one below. Click on EBSCOhost from the menu (it should be the first link).



Step 3.5: You will probably get an error screen after clicking the “EBSCOhost” link. In the address bar, you should now have a web address that says “search.ebscohost.com.exproxy.nvit.ca/login.aspx”. Simply delete everything after “search.ebscohost.com” and hit enter; this should take you to step 4.

Step 4: Choose “Search for journal/magazine articles” from the list of resources. You can also just click the EBSCOhost icon.



Step 5: Click “Select/Deselect all” or select the specific database you want to search, then click Continue.

Step 5.5: If you are specifically wanting to search our eBook collection, select only the databases “eBook Collection (EBSCOhost)” and “eBook Academic Collection (EBSCOhost)”.
